









What are standards?

• A standard is an agreement about a product, a service or a process

Standards reflect best practices

A standard is not a law but meant to be voluntarily applied











Why use standards?



- Increasing efficiency and quality in business, thereby reducing costs
- Ensuring that products or services are better accepted in other countries and support export
- Improving the quality of products or services so customer satisfaction rises
- More environmentally friendly, safe and sustainable products and production processes





Why participate in standardisation?

- Gaining first-hand knowledge: Learn about future technological developments and trends
- Influencing the standards development process: This allows a company to protect its investments in products and research & development
- Building a local network: Belgian standardisation committees are the ideal meeting place to develop new contacts and exchange ideas
- Building an international network: Participating in TC or WG allows you to build international contacts








Role of National Mirror Committee: Vote





Standardisation Processes



Enquiry stage:

- Every project must pass one public review
- First circulation outside the committee
- Available for comments on https://pe.nbn.be/

- NBN

Obligatory
Optional

CEN Standardisation Process

Weighted votes:

≥ 55% of all votes cast are positive (abst. not counted) and the population of the countries having voted positively (abst. not counted) ≥ 65% of the population of all the countries having voted (abst. not counted)

Weighted votes are used for:

- 10 New Work Item
- 40 Public Enquiry (prEN)
- 50 Approval Stage (FprEN)





NBN Standardisation Process

Until 1st April 2021

- Ratification = Bekrachtiging Homologation
 - Belgian standard
 - National amendment
- Registration = Registratie Enregistrement
 - European standard
 - International standard
 - Belgian technical document

Now

- Publication = Publication
 - Belgian standard
 - Consolidated version in case of Amendment
 - European Standard
 - International & foreign standard
 - Belgian technical document





Conclusion

- NBN facilitates the development of NBN, EN and ISO standards
- NBN gives organizations access to knowledge:
 - Create Use Learn Share
- Participation in standardisation may influence the standards development process
- Importance of the Belgian position and vote of the experts
